Registration Details

- Registration will open for those that live or work in Frisco or Copper at **8:00am on Wednesday, August 11, 2021**. Registration will open for non-residents at **12:00pm on Wednesday, August 11, 2021**.
- **Proof of Residency**--If you provided proof of residency or employment in Frisco or Copper for Summer Registration, you are already eligible for early registration. It is not too late to qualify for early registration, please e-mail proof of residency or employment to grantm@townoffrisco.com no later than **12:00pm on Tuesday, August 10, 2021**.

After School Biking

The after school bike program at the Frisco Adventure Park is open to kids ages 5-12. Instructors will guide participants through the bike park and on the Frisco Adventure Park trails to focus on body positioning, balance, and technique as they progress throughout the session. Participants should feel comfortable on a bike. Participants must bring their own bike to the program; bike must have front and rear brakes and gears. No training wheels allowed.

All participants must bring the following to camp:

- Functional bike with gears (no training wheels) – bikes must have front and rear brakes and gears
- Helmet
- Skateboard
- Water bottle
- Snacks
- Bike gloves, elbow, wrist, and knee pads – participants must bring and wear bike gloves, elbow, and knee pads while they are on their bikes
- Sunscreen
- Tennis shoes

Transportation:

Town of Frisco staff will bike to Frisco Elementary to pick up students in the after school biking program. All participants will ride their bikes to the Frisco Adventure Park with their instructor. Participants will need to carry their backpack with them to the program. Parents are asked to please park their child's bike at one of the bike racks at Frisco Elementary.

After School Skateboarding

The after school skateboard program at the Frisco Adventure Park is open to kids ages 5-12. Our instructors will focus on body positioning, balance, and technique and will work on helping participants progress throughout the session. Participants should feel comfortable on a skateboard and must provide their own skateboard, helmet, and protective gear.

All participants must bring the following to camp:

- Functional skateboard
- Helmet, gloves, elbow, and knee pads – must be worn by participants when they are on their skateboards
- Water bottle
- Snacks
- Sunscreen
- Tennis shoes

Little Vikings

Little Vikings is a learn-to-cross country ski program presented by the Town of Frisco and the Summit Nordic Ski Club (SNSC.) The program is open to youth ages 5-12 and offers two, four-week sessions that meet afterschool at the Frisco Nordic Center. This program is non-competitive and is open to all ability levels with a focus on learning to ski and developing good classic-skiing technique.

All participants must bring the following to camp:

- Snow clothes: snow pants, warm jacket, hat, gloves, warm socks
- Snack & water bottle

*Equipment will be rented for the duration of the program and may be used within that timeframe (must bring with you each day of the program.) Once the gear is returned in good condition, we will return your \$50 deposit.

Transportation will be provided from Frisco Elementary; Town of Frisco staff will drive a 15-passenger van to drive the Frisco Nordic Center.

Winter Vacation Sensation (No-School Day Camp)

Winter Vacation Sensation is a state-licensed day camp program that is open to youth ages 5-12. The camp offers themed activities that offer educational opportunities on the days that kids do not have school. Our instructors lead the participants through group activities, team building, arts and crafts, and often times include local field trips to playgrounds.

All participants must bring the following to camp:

- Proper outdoor clothing, according to the daily weather
