Open to youth ages 5-12, Frisco Fun Club is an exciting and adventurous way for your kids to spend the summer. Enjoy week-long, themed activities that offer educational opportunities and activities Monday through Friday, 8:00a.m. to 5:30 p.m., from June 2 through August 17, 2022. Fun Club is a state licensed day camp program and each child needs to have a mandatory camper packet and current immunization records on file prior to their first day of camp.

Frisco Adventure Camp

Adventure camp will offer a variety of activities that are located in and around the Frisco Peninsula including mountain biking, skateboarding, kayaking, hiking, disc golf, and more! The camp is open to youth ages 6-13. All participants must bring the following to the program: bike, helmet, pads, skateboard, water (bladder for backpack preferred), sunscreen, tennis shoes, and a sack lunch with snacks. ****New this year, we will be splitting into two groups based on age. The activity schedule for this program will be the same for all 4 weeks that it is offered.****

Frisco Bike Camp

Open to youth ages 6-13, our instructors will focus on all the Frisco Bike Park features! New this year Camp will be hosted by the Team Summit Bike Program! Participants will learn body positioning, balance and how to maneuver obstacles. Participants should feel comfortable riding a bike and be familiar with breaking, cornering and pumping their bike. The class will also utilize Frisco Peninsula trails with instructors focusing on body positioning, balance, gear shifting and maneuvering over obstacles on the trails. . Participants must bring: bike (**bikes MUST have gears**), helmet, pads, water (bladder for backpack preferred), sunscreen, tennis shoes, and a sack lunch.

Frisco Skateboard Camp

This camp is designed for beginner and intermediate level skateboarders ages 6-13. Our instructors will lead the participants step-by-step through our skate park features with a focus on balance, safety and technique. Participants must bring: skateboard, helmet, pads (required,) water, sunscreen, tennis shoes and lunch. **The activity schedule for this program will be the same for all 3 weeks that it is offered.**

Girls on the Run Camp

Girls on the Run is a program that uses the power of running to help prepare girls for a lifetime of self-respect and healthy living. Through interactive activities, such as running, playing games, and discussing important issues, participants learn how to celebrate being girls. The program focuses on building self-esteem and improving emotional and physical health. This camp is open to girls entering grades 3-6. Girls must bring their lunch to camp every day and dress appropriately for running outside.

We will finish up our adventures with a whitewater rafting trip with Kodi Rafting. The Frisco Bay Marina will provide the necessary gear and expertise. Participants must bring: bathing suits, towels, sack lunch, water bottle, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, warm dry clothes, and water shoes.
