Non-Profit Partnership with Town of Frisco Events

The Town of Frisco Recreation & Culture department recognizes the importance of non-profit organizations in our community and wants to reward them for their service and commitment to community. This year, the Town of Frisco is offering fundraising opportunities available to local non-profits that provide volunteers for various aspects of town events.

This packet is meant to provide detailed information about how to apply for partnership and who is eligible. The following information will outline the opportunities and requirements for eligible non-profit participation.

New Eligibility and Application Guidelines for 2022

Who Can Apply:

- Non-profit partners must be a 501 © (3) (6) or (7) in good standing with the IRS.
- To be considered for partnership with Town of Frisco events, all non– profit organizations must be located and have a physical address in Summit County.

When to Apply:

Non-profit applications will be available from May 9, 2022-May 22, 2022 on the Town website at: <https://www.townoffrisco.com/wp-content/uploads/2022/05/2022-Events-Partnership-Proposal.docx>

Non-Profit application timeline:

- Applications are due no later than 5pm on Sunday, May 22, 2022. There will be no exception for this deadline. If you are mailing in the application, it must be received by the deadline of Sunday, May 22, 2022. A Sunday, May 22, 2022, postmark, and receipt of the application at a later date will not be accepted.
- Notification of participation will be no later than May 24, 2022.

Consideration and selection criteria:

1. A non-profit must submit a complete and accurate application by the deadline of Sunday, May 22, 2022.
2. A non-profit must have a physical location/address in Summit County.
3. A non-profit must be able to recruit volunteers and fulfil the event requirements.
4. All non-profit applications that meet the above criteria will be eligible for partnership.

Volunteer Requirements

- Non-profits will provide the required number of volunteers for each event for the specified date and time.
- Volunteers will arrive on time to the volunteers' pre-race meeting to learn where they are going and what they will be doing
- Volunteers must stay for the entire shift

Compensation

The compensation is \$100/HOUR, with a minimum of 2 people helping at the aid station, packet pickup, or other positions.
