*After School Fun Club provides consistent childcare, running five days a week, after school, at Frisco Elementary School. The program mimics our summer Frisco Fun Club activities, including games, team building, crafts, sports, and more. We are excited to continue to work with The Frosted Flamingo for art activities, the Frisco Historic Park for educational activities, and Thrive Yoga Summit for yoga and mindfulness activities.*

## **Winter Vacation Sensation**

*Winter Vacation Sensation is a state-licensed day camp program that is open to youth ages 5-12. The camp offers themed activities that offer educational opportunities on the days that kids do not have school. Our instructors lead the participants through group activities, team building, arts and crafts, and often times include local field trips to playgrounds.*

## **Little Vikings**

*Little Vikings is a learn-to-cross country ski program presented by the Town of Frisco and the Summit Nordic Ski Club (SNSC.) The program is open to youth ages 5-12 and offers two, four-week sessions that meet after school at the Frisco Nordic Center. This program is non-competitive and is open to all ability levels with a focus on learning to ski and developing good classic-skiing technique.*

All participants must bring the following to camp:

- Snow clothes: snow pants, warm jacket, hat, gloves, warm socks
- Snack & water bottle

Transportation will be provided from Frisco Elementary; Town of Frisco staff will drive a 15-passenger van to drive the Frisco Nordic Center.

The Town of Frisco in collaboration with Team Summit is proud to present Zeke's Shredders! This downhill ski program will be afterschool for kids aged 5-12. This is a skill building program and is not a learn to ski program. All participants must be able to independently ski and stop on their skis. Team Summit will provide coaches for your child to learn new skills and enhance on old ones. Your child must wear a helmet and they must have their own ski/snowboard equipment; we will not be providing rentals.

- **Transportation:** Staff will transport the children from Frisco Elementary to the Frisco Adventure Park. Parents will pick up at the Frisco Adventure Park. If your child does not attend Frisco Elementary school, we cannot provide transportation.
