FRISCO BAY MARINA

The Frisco Bay Marina is located on the shores of scenic Dillon Reservoir in Frisco, Colorado, just nine miles from Breckenridge. The Reservoir spans 3,300 acres and boasts 25 miles of shoreline, surrounded by majestic mountain peaks. It is a world-class destination for paddle sports, power boating, and sailing. At 9,017 feet in elevation, the boating season is weather dependent and typically runs from early June to the end of September.

In 2026, the Marina will offer power boat rentals, paddle sport rentals, tours, mooring rentals, boat storage, and boat repair services. Kids will love the Marina's playground and large sandy beach. Take in the lake views on the Marina's decks and enjoy seasonal outdoor dining (lunch, happy hour, and dinner).

SERVICE

The Frisco Bay Marina is a Yamaha factory-certified service center. While the service department specializes in Evinrude/Johnson/Yamaha outboards, the service staff will work on most other brands of outboards, stern drives, inboards, and diesels as well. The indoor shop can accommodate boats up to 32 feet in length. The service staff can lift boats off trailers and replace standing rigging and running rigging, paint hulls, refinish wood trim, and do fiberglass repairs, accessory installation, and electrical work. Frisco Bay Marina is your full-service, year-round marine repair shop.

FISHING

FISHING PONTOON BOATS

Fishing pontoon boats accommodate five people with room for gear. They drive much like a car, require no special knowledge, and have a 50 HP Yamaha motor built for slow-cruising.

Marina Info + Tips

BOOK AHEAD

Rentals sell out regularly! Reserve in advance.

ARRIVE EARLY

At least 1 hour before your rental time.

PARKING IS LIMITED

Walk or bike if possible. Paid parking applies May 29-Sept 7 (10am-5pm)

GEAR UP

Mountain weather shifts quickly. Bring a hat, fleece, windbreaker, and sunscreen.

STAY FUELED

Bring plenty of water and grab lunch + snacks from a local business for your adventure.

ALL-IN PRICING

Sales tax (8.375%) is included in all prices.

POWER BOAT RENTALS + TOURS

- All power boats are dog friendly.
- All captains must be 18 years of age or older with a valid driver's license and credit card to rent and drive a boat.
- Power boats are perfect for exploring the reservoir but are not suitable for pulling up onto the reservoir's rocky shores, which could damage a motor. However, the paddle sport boats are ideal for pulling onto shore and exploring the islands.
- Food and drink are welcome. There are no grills on rental boats, and you may not bring grills on board.
- No switching of passengers.
- Fuel is included.

PONTOONS

Accommodate 10 or 13 people maximum, drive much like a car, and require no special knowledge. Pontoon boats have a bimini, which covers the back half of the boat, and a 90 hp engine which has "get up and go". Perfect for taking out the whole family or a group of friends and even your canine friend is welcome.

PADDLE SPORT RENTALS

- Dogs are not allowed on paddle sport crafts.
- Anyone 17 or younger must be accompanied by someone 18 or older while on the water at all times.
- Guests must be 13 or older (or weigh over 110 pounds) to command an adult craft (full-size kayak/SUP, tandem kayak, or canoe) on their own.
- Paddle sport rates are per person - no equipment sharing.

TANDEM KAYAKS

Hold 2 people and are great for taking out a child who is not able to go out on their own. The minimum weight requirement for a child passenger is 30lbs.
